

**Q: My ISP disconnect the ADSL connection frequently, how can I make my router to reconnect automatically?**

**A:** You need to turn on the "Automatic Reconnect" option on the router. Please follow the steps below:

1. Open your web browser and type in the **router's IP address** (for example, 10.0.0.2)

2. When asked for Login and Password, Enter:

- Login: **admin**
- Password: **epicrouter**

3. Under "**Configuration -> WAN**". Check the "**Automatic Reconnect**" box under the PPP option.
