

How to configure E-paper in ES-6000

Step1: Under **E-Paper > Subscriber** to create your subscribers' email address entries:



※Note: It is recommended that you perform a regular backup by exporting the account entries to a CONF file in case these settings have been tampered with.

2. The subscribe link and the unsubscribe link may be provided to readers for them to decide whether to subscribe to E-Paper on their own.



Step5: Set the Schedule Sending


Under **E-Paper > Scheduled Sending**, set as below:

- Click **New Entry**.
- Specify the date and time for publication.
- Type the publisher's email address as you want in the **Sender** field.
- Select a subscriber group from the **Group** drop-down list.
- Locate the edited EML file using **Browse** button.



A Scheduled Sending




※**Note:**

1. The **Sender** use **E-Paper > Scheduled Sending** should be identical to the sender of the E-Paper, or the E-paper will not be able to send out.
2. The epaper scheduler will base the sending on the time



How to Remote Access to Manage the E-Paper?

Step7: Setup the Remote Access

Go to **E-Paper > Scheduled Sending** and then set as below:



Step8: The port number is required for accessing the management interface from outside the internal network. The port numbers, based on the protocol is used has to be appended to the management IP address, such as <http://192.168.139.10:84>, while accessing the device remotely.





Clicking Modify to Modify the Schedule




Modifying the Schedule

✘Note:

1. If your Mail Server uses a Virtual IP, you need to specify a port number for the E-Paper administrator to access the Web UI.
2. Each E-Paper administrator can only modify the schedule of his or her own group.
