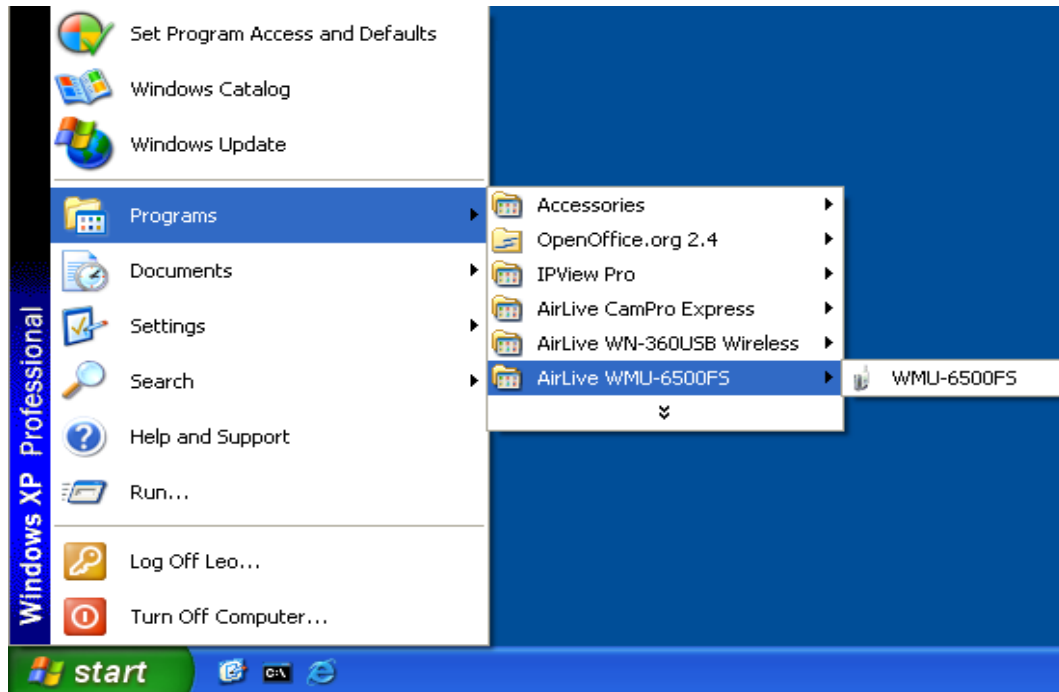


5. Go to Storage Configuration>>Access Control page select Authorization mode and save (use Authorization mode must have two partition ,see the last page please)

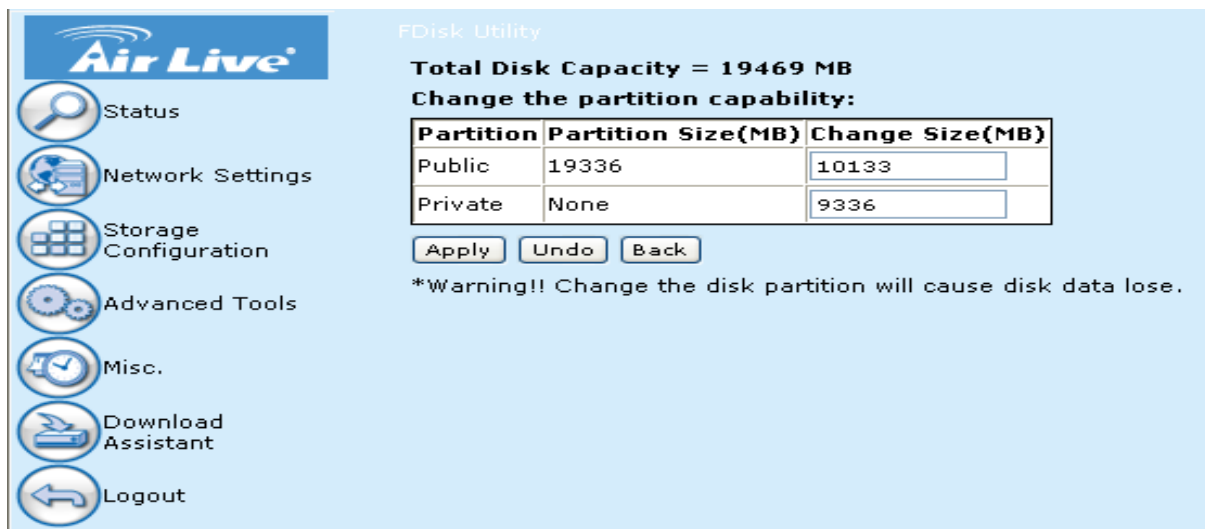

Authorization mode in WMU6500FS

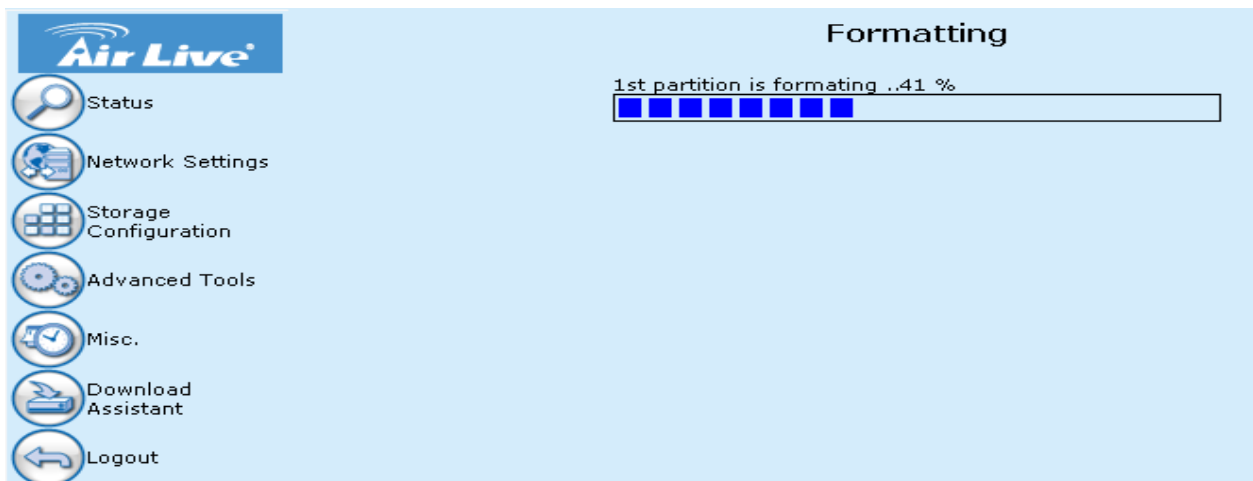
If you use WNU6500FS first time and just have one partition,when you select authorization mode ,system will remind you create private directory
