

- Q: Firmware is crashed, how to recover my AP?
- A: Please refer the followings to upgrade firmware :
- 1. Unplug the power of device.
- Hold the hardware reset button while plugging the power.
 After 15seconds, the Status LED will flash very fast and WLAN LED is off, please release the reset button
- 3. Set your PC's IP address to "Obtain an IP address automatically". Connect the device's LAN port to your PC.

- 6. The procedure will take about three minutes. When the procedure finished, the WLAN LED is on.
- 7. Please unplug and re-plug the power of your device manually.
- Please wait a while until it boots up (about 1 minute).
 Then press the hardware reset button over 10 seconds to restore it to factory default setting. After resetting, the device's IP is 192.168.1.254.
- Your PC will get DHCP from device, so the IP of your PC will be 192.168.1.xxx.
 Open your web browser, and then type " http://192.168.1.254".
 You will get into the web management.
